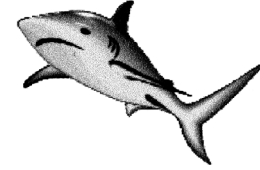
*People/teams to enter and 3 judges to judge

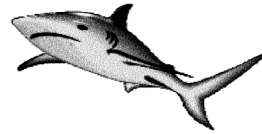
Some thoughts on season 2006 from some of our Sharks....

Reminder of Pool Use

The Board would like to take this opportunity to remind homeowners on the use of the pool. It is the responsibility of every homeowner in Shadow Brook to review the pool rules which are conveniently posted on the website. We take the well-being of our facility and the safety of our staff very seriously. Further, homeowners are reminded that they take full responsibility for the actions and behavior of their guests. Below are some highlighted rules from the website.

Under General Rules:

- *Intoxicated persons are not allowed on the property and will be asked to leave.*
- *Employees, members and guests will at all times conduct themselves in a manner which demonstrates respect for others and for those observing their behavior*

Under Pool Rules:

- *No breakable containers are permitted in the pool area.*
*Smoking is allowed **ONLY** in the parking lot.*

Enforcement:

- *The pool staff is empowered by the Board of Directors to enforce all of the above rules and when required may expel or exclude any person violating them. Questions may be referred to the Pool VP or the Board of Directors at any regularly scheduled Board Meeting.*

According to our CCR's, section 7b:

7. SHADOW BROOK SWIM CLUB: OPERATION OF POOLS. ...Board of Directors of the Club has the power to:

Suspend for a reasonable period, not exceeding 30 days, the right of an Owner or other person to use the pool in the event the Directors, following a hearing upon reasonable notice, determined by a four-fifths vote that such person has willfully violated any reasonable rule promulgated by the Directors pursuant to these restrictions or failed to pay any assessment for which he is liable.

It is up to the Board and pool staff to ensure that *all* residents have a safe and fun time while at the pool. Please keep these rules in mind while enjoying the pool.

Swimming at the Shadow Brook Pool

I hope everyone is enjoying the summer. The pool has been a busy place this summer. It has been nice to see so many families taking advantage of our pool. It is part of what makes Shadow Brook so special.

After some feedback on these excruciatingly hot days, we will stay open until 9pm. on the evenings which warrant more cool, pool time. Because this will be sporadic, the guards will decide by 6pm of that day and post it on the message board.

Speaking of heat...we all experienced long, hot power outages. Please be aware that if there is a power failure at the pool we must **evacuate** the pool immediately according to the California Health and Safety Code and the County Health Department. This is because the filter and the chlorinator stop working. Though the code might seem overboard or illogical to some, it is nonetheless, the code which we must follow. Unfortunately, pool closure sometimes happens on the hottest of days or during a planned, private party. We must abide by the code for the health and safety of our residents and guests. We appreciate your patience and cooperation as we comply with the County code.

Here are some general guideline to assist pool personnel and guests:

- if the power fails one hour before normal closing time, everyone will be asked to leave and the guards will close the facility.
- if the power fails during the course of the day, the facility will stay open for 1 hour and people may stay. If the power has not returned in 1 hour, then the facility will close for the day and people will be asked to leave.
- any planned parties which are affected by the closure will be refunded for all guest and party fees.

I hope this help clarify any concerns on this issue. We are always thinking of ways to make our pool more accommodating and fun.
