# ACC 2016 Spring Drive Around

This spring the ACC will be driving around the neighborhood to inspect Shadow Brook homes' front yard conditions. The state and governor rules prevent the HOA from doing much about front yards not receiving water. As a result of the drought, many front yards have been neglected. As a friendly reminder, the HOA requires all Homeowners to still maintain the appearance of your front yard.

The ACC will be looking for the following elements and issuing notices to homeowners:

- Weeds not cut down to ground level
- Dead plants and dead/bare lawns
- Excessive weeds around and under landscaping shrubs

We hope all Shadow Brook homeowners see the value in maintaining front yards which helps improve the overall value of our neighborhood.

# **Message from the Board**

As you know Shadow Brook will be implementing Phase II of the new pool entry process this season. Phase I introduced checking in at the gate using our Membership Database rather than simply signing a sheet and walking in. This first phase ensured that our records were current. It also allowed us to verify who was walking in to the pool. Phase II is the issuing of Membership Cards to each Household. Thus far, over 60 Homeowners and Associate Members have obtained cards. The feedback the Board has received has been positive in that we now have a method for verifying who is using our facility.

The Board would like to issue as many cards as possible prior to the Memorial Day opening. Below are a few times when cards can be obtained. Once the pool is open, cards can be obtained during pool hours. Receiving a card prior to our opening will help us alleviate long waiting times. 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#### 4th of July T-Shirt Contest Rules


- If your child is interested in submitting artwork for our tshirts, see the details below and submit them to Staci Tenczar no later than June 10th.
