## Architectural Control Committee (ACC) Update

The largest number of complaints from Homeowners to the Board and ACC pertain to the condition of the neighborhood, specifically home and yard conditions. It's clear there are properties that have deteriorated.

### Spring Drive Around

While the ACC enforces our CCR's year-round, every year the ACC does a drive around the entire Shadow Brook neighborhood to inspect every home for compliance with our Policies and CCR's.

We will be looking primarily for the following:

1. Landscaping, dead or weed infested lawns, dead shrubs or trees, plants overgrowing sidewalks
2. Home appearance, peeling paint, missing trim or shutters, neglected fencing, garbage cans or debris in front yard

The ACC will work with Homeowners on fixing dirt lawns, peeling paint and other visible violations.
