

## **Member Checklist**

\*What to Expect when Arriving at the Pool\*

1. Members must park in every other spot in the parking lot to maintain social distance
2. Members must wait outside of the front gate on the dots in the parking lot until the social distance monitor allows them to enter
3. Members must be wearing their swim suit when they arrive at the pool
4. Every member entering must be wearing a mask or they will not be allowed to enter.
5. The social distance monitor will allow one household in at a time providing members with hand sanitizer and a liability form unless they have already signed one
6. After providing hand sanitizer, the social distance monitor will then instruct the members which zone they will be lap swimming or family swimming in
7. Once all members are in their respective zones, the session will begin
8. Bathrooms are to be only used by one member at a time and are limited to toilet use only.
9. During the session the following will not be allowed:
  - a. Water fountain and Shower usage
  - b. Loitering on deck
  - c. Use of pool furniture except for the benches in designated zones
  - d. Food or alcohol. Water bottles are permitted.
  - e. Food deliveries
  - f. BBQ and Kitchens usage
10. With 5 minutes left in the session, the lifeguard on the stand will blow a long whistle to make the members aware that the time of the session is almost up
11. At the end of the session, the lifeguard will blow another long whistle signalling that the session is up and members must leave the pool vicinity
12. Once out of the water, the social distance monitor will instruct members to leave through the back gate near kitchen to prevent crossing paths with other individuals
13. Please be sure to be safe when entering and exiting the parking lot
