Ballots for the November 9, 2021 election were mailed to eligible homeowners on October 4, 2021 and must be returned by mail to the Shadow Brook PO Box or in person to the Inspector of Elections, Lydia McClure, at the pool entrance no later than 7:15 pm on Tuesday, November 9, 2021 at the Shadow Brook Fall General Meeting. If you have not received a ballot, then email <a href="mailto:splasher@shadowbrook.org">splasher@shadowbrook.org</a> immediately and we will have one delivered to your home right away. The election is conducted in

accordance with the 2020 Shadow Brook Swim Club and Homeowners' Association Election Operating Rules.

The actual fall Shadow Brook Homeowners meeting will primarily be held via Zoom as usual during these pandemic times. The agenda will be posted on the website prior to the meeting. Because of the election, you are welcome to attend at the pool where the ballots will be opened and counted, or on-line to the extent that we can set up a parallel virtual system via ZOOM. The Election Inspectors will be available at the pool parking lot to receive your ballots on the day of the Fall General Meeting (November  $9^{th}$ ) from 6:00 pm - 7:15 pm
