The pool remains open this Fall

Fall Lap Swimming: As the summer season comes to a close, pool availability will continue for members (at no additional cost) and 2021 summer associates who have signed up for the Fall season, age 18 and older, week days, 7 am to 2:30 pm; Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 5:30 to 7:30 pm and weekends from 12 noon to 8 pm. This lap swimming program is available for everyone 18 years and older.

Fall Family Swimming: Starting the weekend of October 2/3, and hopefully for future weekends in October and November, the pool will also be available for family swim time from 2 pm to 6 pm, although this will be on a trial basis. Lap swimming will continue on the weekends, but just from 12 to 2 pm and 6 to 8 pm. The Family swimming program is available to all members and those 2021 summer associates who sign up for Fall Lap Swimming. Lane lines will remain in the pool during family swim and lifeguards will not be on duty at any time this fall. Family pool use is open to Shadow Brook members and children, and also Fall Associate members and their immediate household members.

Guests and Parties will not be allowed during the Fall Season. **Bathrooms will not be open during weekdays.**

The Brivo Mobile Pass smartphone app will be the only way to open the pool gate. Each person age 18 or older must sign a waiver to receive their Brivo pass; anyone over 18 who intends to bring household members to the pool should include all of those names on their waiver. Please see the website under the POOL tab for full details including how to sign up. Guests and Parties will not be allowed during the Fall Season.

Repairs continue on the pool as well. Our 50+ year old facility needs constant attention with more and more items in need of repair and replacement. The next big item will be pool replastering, which appears to not have been done for more than 10 years. The contractor's schedule is now set and the pool will be shut down for 6 weeks starting January 17th. We hope to be done at the end of February, but this is dependent upon cooperating weather and may extend for a week or possibly two. The replastering includes new tile, coping, moving the ladders, and repair of structural cracks.

Remember to regularly check the website for updates and changes as we progress through these new activities.

Hot Spinach and Crab Dip

INGREDIENTS

2 tbsp. butter
 1 small onion
 finely chopped
 1 clove garlic
 finely chopped
 8 oz. cream
 cheese room
 temperature
 1 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
 ½ tsp dry mustard
 ½ tsp paprika
 ⅛ tsp cayenne
 1 lb frozen spinach thawed and
 squeezed dry
 8 oz lump crab meat pick through
 for shell pieces!
 ½ c. Monterey Jack shredded
 3 tbsp. grated Parmesan
 2 tbsp. Panko breadcrumbs



DIRECTIONS

1. Start by melting the butter in a medium pot at medium heat. When the butter is melted, add the onion and garlic and saute until softened. Then add in the cream cheese, Worcestershire, mustard, paprika, and cayenne and mixing until combined. When the cream cheese has incorporated, mix in the spinach and crab meat and stir until it begins to bubble. Then mix in the cheeses and season with salt and pepper to taste.
2. When the dip is mixed, you can transfer to a baking dish and top with Panko crumbs before baking for 15 minutes at 425°F. Or you can transfer the dip to a Crock-Pot and set on "High" until you're ready to serve. Enjoy!
