

Shadow Brook Fall Election Results Report

The Shadow Brook community successfully completed the Fall 2021 Board Election on November 9, 2021, in compliance with the "Shadow Brook Swim Club and Homeowners Association Election Operating Rules, adopted by the Board on March 25, 2020. Our community will benefit from the continued creativity, dedication, enthusiasm and hard work of the 5 current Board members and welcome a new Board member to fill a vacant slot. It is encouraging to see the willingness of these neighbors to accept the challenge to keep Shadow Brook a great place to live and raise a family.

I am pleased to announce that the neighbors showed their support for the entire slate of candidates to serve for the 2022 Board year commencing January 1, 2022.

Here's the breakdown of results:

315 property owners in Shadow Brook were eligible to vote and received a ballot by mail on November 3rd.

25% quorum exceeded with 136 property owner ballots returned

Total ballots accepted: 126

Total ineligible ballots due to homeowner failure to follow Election Instructions: 10

Results:

Number of cumulative candidate votes: 745 with voters authorized to cast 6 votes per ballot

There was no eligible write in qualified candidate votes cast

All candidates received over 100 votes with individually very close margins

Result was 5 incumbents and one candidate were elected with majority of votes.
