Peanut Blossom Cookies



INGREDIENTS

- -1¾ cups all-purpose flour
- -1 teaspoon baking soda
- -1/2 teaspoon salt
- -4 ounces (1 stick) of butter, at room temperature
- -1/2 cup smooth peanut butter (or other creamy nut butter)
- -1⁄2 cup granulated sugar, plus more for rolling
- -1/2 cup light brown sugar
- -1 large egg
- -1 tablespoon milk, half-and-half, oat milk or nut milk
- -1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- -Nonstick spray or vegetable oil for cookie sheet (optional)
- -5 dozen (one 11-ounce package) Hershey's Kisses, the foil removed

DIRECTIONS

- 1. Sift together flour, baking soda, and salt; set aside. Using an electric mixer, cream together butter, peanut butter, ½ cup granulated sugar, and light brown sugar. Add egg, milk, and vanilla; beat until well blended. Gradually add the flour mixture, mixing thoroughly. If the dough is very soft, refrigerate for about 1 hour.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 375 degrees. Spray, oil or line a cookie sheet with a nonstick liner and set aside. Roll dough into 1-inch balls. (For a precise number of cookies, divide the dough into 5 pieces, and shape each portion into 12 balls.)
- 3. Roll cookies in sugar and place 2 inches apart on the cookie sheet. Bake until very light brown and puffed, 6 to 8 minutes. Remove the sheet from the oven and lightly press a candy kiss into the center of each cookie, allowing it to crack slightly. Return to oven until light golden brown, 2 to 3 minutes. Remove from the oven, cool completely, and store in an airtight container.
