- Ballot Materials Sent Oct. 28th
- Mail-In Ballot Deadline Nov. 25th
- Voting Deadline Nov. 29th
- Election Day Nov. 29th
- Notice of Election Results Anytime before Dec. 14th

Important Reminder: Per Civ. Code § 5105(a)(7), all HOA members are permitted to verify the accuracy of their individual information on the "Voter list" and "Candidate list" at least thirty (30) days before ballots are distributed (**deadline of September 28, 2023**). 
